

Periodicals on Masonic Periodicals Online

The Freemason

Published by George Kenning as *The Freemason: a Weekly Journal of Freemasonry, Literature, Science and Art*, the magazine was in print from 1869 until 1940 and then irregularly from 1948 until 1951. In 1906, it was taken over by John Denyer Hand and became, *The Freemason and Masonic Illustrated*. Only issues published between 1869 and 1901 are included on *Masonic Periodicals Online*, which is missing the whole of January 1873, 5th December 1874, 7th February 1885, 28th March 1885 and 4th April 1885, although these and the later issues are available to readers in the Library and Museum of Freemasonry.

Freemasons Chronicle

Published weekly by A.W.Morgan, *The Freemasons' Chronicle: a Weekly Record of Masonic Intelligence* was in print from 1875 until 1957. Only issues published between 1875 and 1901 are included on *Masonic Periodicals Online*, which is missing 5th June 1886 and 12th November 1887, although these and later issues are available to readers in the Library and Museum of Freemasonry.

Freemasons Magazine

Originally printed and published as *Freemasons' Magazine: or, General and Complete Library* by J. W. Bunney, this monthly illustrated magazine ran over seven volumes from June 1793 until December 1796 by which time it was being published by George Cawthorn. He changed the title to *The Scientific Magazine and Freemason's Repository* and it ran for another four volumes (VIII to XI) published between January 1797 and December 1798.

Freemasons Magazine and Masonic Mirror

Originally called *The Freemasons' Monthly Magazine* and published by George Routledge between January 1855 and December 1855 as a continuation of *The Freemasons' Quarterly Magazine*. In 1856 the publication was taken over by Henry George Warren as *The Freemasons' Magazine and Masonic Mirror*, who changed the publication to a weekly from 1858 until 1871.

Freemasons Quarterly Review

Published quarterly as *The Freemasons' Quarterly Review* by William Wilcockson and sold in London, Edinburgh and Dublin between 1834 and 1849. It was renamed *The Freemasons' Quarterly Magazine and Review* by Richard Spencer, who published the magazine between 1850 and 1852, who changed the title again in 1853 to *The Freemasons' Quarterly Magazine*, which he published in partnership with George Routledge until 1854.

Masonic Examiner

The Masonic Examiner: a Monthly Medium of Information and Communication for Brethren of Every Rite and Degree, Recognised and Un-recognised, was published by its editor, Matthew Cooke and ran from July to December 1871.

Masonic Illustrated

A heavily illustrated monthly published over six volumes between 1900 and 1906. The first three volumes of *The Masonic Illustrated: a Monthly Journal for Freemasons*, were published by Spencer & Co, Great Queen Street, the next three by Warrington & Co., also of Great Queen Street. *Masonic Illustrated* merged with *The Freemason* in 1906.

Masonic Magazine

The Masonic Magazine: a Monthly Digest of Freemasonry in all its Branches was published by George Kenning between 1873 and 1882 as a monthly supplement to *The Freemason*.

Masonic Mirror

The Masonic Mirror was a monthly published by Henry George Warren between November 1854 and December 1855, which amalgamated with *The Freemasons' Monthly Magazine* to become *The Freemasons' Magazine and Masonic Mirror* in 1856.

Masonic Monthly

The Masonic Monthly, published by George Kenning between July and December 1882, as a continuation of *The Masonic Magazine: a Monthly Digest of Freemasonry in all its Branches*.

The Masonic Observer

The Masonic Observer was published by Simpkin, Marshal & Co, London and Robert Edward Peach, Bath from 1856 until 1859, mostly as a quarterly. A longer title, *The Masonic Observer and Grand Lodge Chronicle* was adopted from December 1856.

Masonic Press

Published by its editor, Matthew Cooke, *The Masonic Press: a Monthly Journal, Review and Chronicle, of Freemasonry and its Kindred Subjects, etc.*, was a monthly that only ran for four issues, January to April 1866.

Masonic Review

The Masonic Review: a Monthly Journal of Masonic and Social Events for Freemasons was published between July 1889 and December 1890 from the offices of *The Masonic Review* in Chancery Lane. The Library and Museum of Freemasonry does not hold copies from April to August 1890, so these are not included on *Masonic Periodicals Online*.

Masonic Star

Published by the Adams Brothers of the Adambury Press, Fleet Street, *The Masonic Star: a Weekly Journal and Record of Freemasonry at Home and Abroad*, was a weekly that ran from 23rd August 1888 until 22nd August 1889.
